





The company is focusing on continuous operations amidst the enhanced community quarantine to address the current scarcity of alcohol in the market and contribute to combating the COVID-19 pandemic.

Manna Shameyn Enterprise designs and fabricates hospital beds and medical equipment such as stretchers, bedside cabinets, over-bed tables, medicines and instrument trolleys, instrument cabinets, and baby basinet for health care institutions and hospitals.

The company continues to produce the increasing requirements of various hospitals and healthcare institutions in the country despite the enhanced community quarantine (ECQ) due to COVID-19 to continuously serve the needs of the patients. On a monthly average, the company manufactures 100 units of hospital beds and 170 pcs of various medical equipment.

D0ST's assistance on process improvement and technology and equipment upgrading resulted in the improvement of their product quality and reduction in production cycle time from 10 days to 5 days.

Approved Proposals

- Development of Sixty (66) Units of Swab Testing Stations and Conduct of Testing and Data Gathering in Selected Areas
 - Mass testing booths that can be done without direct contact with the people being tested
 - Reduces risk of frontline health workers of getting infected





Approved Proposals

- Production of Six (6) Units of the Artificial Intelligence-based Thermal Scan Technology, Pilot Testing and Deployment in Selected LGUs
 - An Al-based thermal scanner mounted in drones or station bays
 - Able to scan and identify people with high temperature
 - Reduces screening time and closer exposure of frontline workers
